

**Report on Pulse Polio Immunization Program**

Pulse Polio is an immunisation campaign established by the government of India to eliminate poliomyelitis (polio) in India by vaccinating all children under the age of five years against the polio virus. The project fights poliomyelitis through a large-scale, pulse vaccination programme and monitoring for polio cases. With the global initiative of eradication of polio in 1988 following World Health Assembly resolution in 1988, Pulse Polio Immunization programme was launched in India in 1995.

The students (88 MMS II year) participated in a week long Pulse Polio Immunization campaign under the aegis of Institutional Social Responsibility (ISR) Committee and NSS team, from 5th August 2018 to 10th August 2018 at Bandra Terminus railway station.

Oral polio doses were administered to 256 children under the age of five years. Prof. Yogesh Ingle (Assistant Professor, SRBS), was the program coordinator with Dr. Pankaj Apoorva, Mrs. Shettye and their team from BMC spear headed the campaign. They appreciated the contribution of the institute towards the social cause.
